

The **Fruit and Nut Tree Network** keeps lists of:

1. fruit and nut trees grown on private land;
2. fruit and nut trees grown on public land;
3. people willing to share/barter their surplus fruit and nuts;
4. skill and information sharing on fruit and nut growing and adding value;
5. people wanting news (updates on fruit and nut knowledge and activities).

Data provided to List 1 are anonymous. We simply collect data and let people know, through our news bulletin (List 5) and other media, what fruits and nuts are grown in different areas.

Data provided to List 2, fruit and nut trees on public land, will be made public. For List 2 you can just let us know what exists without leaving your name or other contact details.

Data provided to List 3 — if and when you have surplus to share or barter you need to ask us to notify interested people through our news bulletin. Sometimes we will ask people on List 3 if they can contribute via gift or barter to Slow Food Blue Mountains workshops or for catering.

We will pass on details of List 4, people wanting to share associated skills and knowledge, too.
